22nd Capt. S. J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship- Novices-2018[Capt. SJEMMSSC]

The 22nd Capt. S. J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship for Novices (NR Category) [Capt. SJEMMSSC] will be held from 19.04.2018 to 23.04.2018. The Championship will be conducted by the Mumbai Suburban District Rifle Association and organized by the Maharashtra Rifle Association, at the MRA Shooting Ranges, Worli Sea face North, Mumbai 400 030. The scores achieved in this competition will be recognized for participation in the forthcoming 28th All India G. V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship [AIGVMSC].

Prior to submission of entry forms, participants must have completed the **Safety course**, submitted the **Undertaking cum Indemnity Bond** and the **Shooters Sports Registration Form.** Participants, Clubs/DRA's must pay all their dues/outstanding payable to the Maharashtra Rifle Association, without which no entry forms, will be accepted.

Eligibility for Participation in the 22nd Capt. SJEMMSC:

A shooter who has **not** previously **achieved the scores** shown in the chart **'A'** - <u>on page 3 -</u> in any National level Competition conducted by NRAI including All India G.V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship, West Zone Shooting Championship, Maharashtra State Shooting Championship and Capt. S. J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship - Novices(NR Category) and has not won any medals at the State Championship - MSSC or National Championship - NSCC in that event, is eligible to participate in the above mentioned competition in that event.

A shooter who has shot any peep sight rifle events at the MSCC / NSCC cannot shoot open sight rifle events.

Eligibility for participating in the 35th MSSC-2018

A shooter who has achieved the minimum qualifying score – MQS - [as mentioned in chart 'A', on page 3] in the respective event, in any competition recognized by the MRA, in the last 5 years i.e. from 01.01.2014 until the MSSC 2018, is eligible to participate in that event, in the 35th Maharashtra State Shooting Championship – MSSC.

A shooter who is desirous of participating in the 34th MSSC-2018 in any event but has not achieved the MQS required for that event, or has not achieved the MQS after 01.01.2013.

a. Participate / compete in the 22nd Capt. SJEMMSSC and achieve the MQS. [if s/he is not eligible to compete in the 22nd Capt. SJEMMSSC]

OR

b. Achieve the MQS by shooting a **Qualifying Trial**, to be shot concurrently with the competitors of the 22nd Capt. SJEMMSSC. S/he should make a written application to the MRA to conduct a qualifying trial concurrently with the above competition for events in which s/he desires to qualify. These scores will be recognized only for the purpose of qualifying for the MSSC/AIGVM and for no other purpose. No medals/certificates will be awarded for the same.

Shooters who are Medal winners of the State or the National Championships would be eligible to participate in the 35th MSSC irrespective of any of the above rules.

AMMUNITION:

Imported ammunition and Pellets will be issued to all participants as per the norms approved by the Managing Committee and as per the availability. Details of the norms and issue procedures for imported ammunition/pellets will be put up on the Notice Board at the MRA Shooting Range prior to the commencement of the competition. Participants should keep in touch with the 'Notice Board' for updated information.

- 1. Shooters desiring to participate in the competition should complete the attached entry form, along with entry fee by proof of cash deposited into Mumbai Suburban District Rifle Association [MSDRA] account (original cash deposit slip), and send to the MRA office. Entry fee may ONLY be paid to the MSDRA Bank Account, [Bank of Maharashtra a/c no 20008359428 MAHB0000978 Goregaon [E], Mumbai]. The last date of receipt of single entry fee is 13.04.2018. Entries may be accepted until 15.04.2018 with a payment of double entry fee. On evaluation forms which are found to be INCOMPLETE will be rejected.
- 2. Entry forms without appropriate entry fee, will be rejected
- 3. All weapons and ammunition must comply with NRAI / ISSF Rules.
- 4. All the matches will be conducted as per ISSF rules & NRAI Match Book.
- 5. Participants will have to bring their own arms/ammunition and other equipments. ONE WEAPON, CAN BE SHARED BY, NOT MORE THAN 2 SHOOTERS.
- 6. All shooters must shoot in the details allocated to them. Absentees will not be allowed to take part in a later detail even if a lane is vacant in that detail. If a shooter is absent, another shooter will not be permitted to shoot in his place.
- **7.** Allocation of relays and firing points will be done by the Organizing Committee. The particulars of details will be put up on the Notice Board **two** days prior to the date of the actual event and all participants should keep themselves informed by referring to the Notice Board. **No request regarding specific firing points / relays / dates will be entertained.**
- **8.** Shooters are required to be present at the firing point 15 minutes prior to the commencement of their respective details.

- 9. A shooter who does not complete 21/18 years of age, on or before 31.12.2018 will be considered a Junior or Youth shooter respectively.
- 10. Medals and/or Certificates stating Medal and/or corresponding Ranking will be awarded only to those shooters who qualify for participation in the forthcoming 28th All India G.V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship in that event. The qualification score for each event is mentioned in 'Chart 'A'/page 3 of this circular and are scores as specified by the National Rifle Association of India in its Match Book. No Medals and/or Certificates stating the Rank will be issued to shooters who do not fulfill the above criterion of qualifying for participation in the forthcoming 28th AIGVMSC. The organizing committee reserves the right to relax this rule in the case of junior and Youth shooters.
- 11. Medals will be awarded to one less than the total number of participants actually shooting and completing the competition. **Medals will be given to the participants ONLY during the respective Prize Distribution ceremony.** No medals will be awarded at a later date. Participation Certificates will be awarded only to those shooters who shoot a minimum score as per the chart below.

The above scores are the minimum qualifying scores for participation at the 28th AIGVMSC & 35th MSSC –2018

No qualifying trials will be conducted for the **Rapid fire event**. Any shooter who is a Renowned Shot in in any 25Mtr event is qualified to shoot in the Rapid fire event in the MSSC – 2018.

Only those events in which there is a minimum of 4 entries will be conducted. Events in which there are less than 4 entries will be cancelled. If there is a paucity of entries in any event, the shooters of that event will automatically be moved to the next higher category. A shooter may shoot a qualifying trial for score/eligibility in the case of his event being cancelled due to paucity of entries. However these scores will not be considered for medals/ certificates. AN EVENT SHALL TAKE PLACE ONLY IF THERE ARE A MINIMUM OF 4 ENTRIES.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE for the participants of the FIREARM EVENTS:

Competitors who are desirous of participating in the pistol/peep sight rifle – firearm events, must have fulfilled the following: (a). Must have trained for at least 3 sessions/matches with the firearm that s/he would use in the competition in the presence of an authorized official of the MRA/DRA/Club/registered unit

(b). The official must certify that the shooter has achieved the requisite qualifying score [Chart A] in at least one training session.

ANY FALSE DECLARATION IS LIABLE FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

Shooters desirous of using MRA firearms must inform the MRA, of the date/s on which s/he would like to train and shoot the practice matches in the presence of an authorized official. Shooters requiring coaching for the different matches in the firearm events may inform the MRA and the same would be arranged.

This rule would not apply to those shooters who have achieved the requisite score in previous [recognized] competitions.

A SHOOTER WOULD NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FIREARMS EVENTS WITHOUT THE BONAFIDE CERTIFICATE OF 3 PRACTISE SESSIONS.

- 4. Shooter must **carry valid Identification proof** (Passport / Aadhar Card /driving license or any other Govt. recognized IDI- along with a valid Rifle Club / DRA membership Card. They would be required to show the same on demand to any officer authorized by the MRA..
- 5. All Shooters must ensure that they are in proper permitted clothing **prohibited clothing like blue jeans** will not be permitted on the firing line during practice or match. As per the new ISSF rule on clothing Jeans of all type, pant/shorts with pockets on the outside like Cargo pants, sleeveless Tops, shorts which are above the arm length of the shooter, Chappals and Sandals are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED/NOT PERMITTED** during competition.
