Sub: **SYSTEM AND PROCEDURE FOR SELECTING SHOOTERS (RIFLE/PISTOL) FOR NATIONAL SQUAD – NSQ 2016 and for 2015 post the 58th NSCC and 2 NRC.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

1. The selection for the National Squad for the year 2016 will be based on the ranking policy. The shooters will be selected in the National Squad 2016 as per their ranking which will be based on the formula adopted by the NRAI for the selection of shooters for participation in International competitions 2016.
2. The following procedure will be followed for selection of members of National Squad for the year 2016 and for 2015 post completion of 58th NSCC and 2 NRC

The Governing Body of the NRAI in its meeting held on 18th October 2014 has decided to follow the Ranking System as laid down in the Ranking Policy effective from 58th NSCC onwards. This may be amended prior to the 59th NSCC. It was further decided that for the year 2015 the ranking policy will be adopted post the 58th NSCC and two RCs. On the completion of the 58th NSCC the NSQ would be decided on the basis of the old formula as declared in November 2013 but on the completion of the 3 above stated competitions [58th NSCC and a minimum of 2 NRC] the NSQ 2015 would be revised as per the ranking policy. [adopted by the Governing Body in its meeting of 18.10.2014]

- A. A maximum of first eight Senior shooters in each event who fulfill the above condition and ranked according to their ranking subject to achieving MQS as per annexure "A" will be taken into the National squad.
- B. A maximum of six junior shooters in each event can be selected – if needed- even if shooters have not achieved the qualifying average score for National Squad 2016.
- C. Junior shooters will be part of junior national squad even if they qualify for senior national squad.
- D. A maximum of ten youth shooters in each event of air weapons can be selected for National Squad 2016.
- E. These 10 shooters to be selected in following manner:

For Pistol – First 4 shooters as per ranking of NSQ 2016 and 2 shooters each from the age group 15 yrs., 14yrs., 13yrs.

For Rifle – First 4 shooters as per ranking of NSQ 2016 and 3 shooters each from the age group 15 yrs., 14yrs.

- F. The National Champions of 59th NSCC in open events will be included in the squad irrespective of their ranking. Junior National Champions in open junior events and Junior NSQ shooters who are in transit in the year 2016 can be included in senior NSQ.
- G. In case of tie, shooters having same scores will be taken into the National Squad.
- H. Shooters selected by NRAI to participate in international competitions during 2016 may be considered for selection in the National Squad.

II CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION IN TRIALS

1. **Members of the National Squad** for 2015 will be eligible to participate in the above trials at Govt Cost only in those events where they are Members of the NSQ .

1.1. For participation in other events, Members of the NSQ will be treated as other shooters qualified to participate in the selection trials at own cost - hence Members NSQ who are qualified as per Annexure " B " to participated in an event and intend to participate in that other event must submit their entry form along with fee within the stipulated time.

. Also no ammunition will be issued by SAI for for participation these events

2. Those who are **not members of the National Squad** will be allowed to participate in the selection trials at their own cost in case:

2.1. They achieve minimum qualifying scores during 58th NSCC as per annexure "B" enclosed.

2.2. Or they have an average qualifying score based on 3 higher scores during the year 2014.

2.3. International Shooters will be permitted in those events in which they have participated in international competitions without any MQS as per annexure "A".

For participation in international competitions at own cost all shooters/affiliated units are required to acquaint themselves with the norms for such participation as stated in the Ranking Policy (Rifle/Pistol)

The final decision regarding any of the clauses above will be with the Selection Committee/ NRAI and this decision will be final and binding on all concerned.
