Maharashtra Air and Firearms Competition [SHOTGUN] NR/ISSF – September – 2026/2 [MAFC Shotgun 2026/2]

To,
All Affiliated District Association/Clubs/Unit.

The Maharashtra Air and Firearms Competition Shotgun NR/ISSF September 2026/2, will be organised by the Maharashtra Rifle Association and conducted by the Pune Shooting Sports Association, from 04.09.2026 to 08.09.2026 at the Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex, Mahalunge- Balewadi, Pune - 411045. That the said competition shall be held at the aforementioned venue subject to approval from the competent authority. The scores achieved in this competition will be recognized for participation in the forthcoming Zonal Competition.

Prior to submission of entry forms, participants must fill the **Online Registration**. Participants, Clubs/DRA's must pay all their dues/outstanding payable to the Maharashtra Rifle Association, without which no entry forms, will be accepted.

The last date of receipt of entries is 26.08.2026 till 1700 hrs. via MRA's online portal – www.maharifle.org.

Eligibility for Participation in the MAFC-

A shooter who has not previously shot the scores shown in the **Chart 'A'** in any National level Competition organised by a) NRAI including All India G.V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship, West Zone Shooting and b) organized by MRA - Maharashtra State Shooting Championship and Capt. S.J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship- Novices(NR Category) and has not won any medals at the State Championship – MSSC or National Championship – in that event, is eligible to participate in the above mentioned competition in that event.

MQS shooters For the purposes of this competition, those shooters are "**MQS**" shooters who have participated earlier in the NSCC/ G.V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship, West Zone Shooting Championship, Maharashtra State Shooting Championship and Capt. S. J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship- Novices (NR Category), but are required to once again achieve the required MQS to participate in the Pre-National Competitions.

Zero shooters [ISSF] For the purposes of this competition, those athletes who are eligible to participate in the forthcoming NSCC in their respective events are eligible to participate as Zero Shooter.

SCORES ACHIEVED IN THE ZERO SHOOTER CATEGORY IN THE PRESENT COMPETITION SHALL BE CONSIDERED FOR SELECTION OF TEAMS FOR THE FORTHCOMING NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

DOUBLE TRAP EVENTS- In view of Double Trap event not being conducted at the international level, it has been decided that the said event shall be conducted only for training purposes at the State Level (There shall be a common entry for all athletes intending to participate in Double Trap Events). That no medal/certificate/ recommendation for Arms License (Aspiring) shall be granted to athletes participating only in Double Trap Events.

COMPETITION RULES-

1. The last date of receipt of single entries is 26.08.2026 till 1700 hrs. and entries may be accepted upon payment of double entry fee till 1700 hrs. on 28.08.2026.
2. All weapons and ammunition must comply with NRAI / ISSF Rules.
3. All the matches will be conducted as per ISSF rules & NRAI Match Book.
4. Participants will have to bring their own arms/ammunition and other equipment's. ONE WEAPON, CAN BE SHARED BY, NOT MORE THAN 2 SHOOTERS.
5. All shooters must shoot in the details allocated to them. Absentees will not be allowed to take part in a later detail even if a lane is vacant in that detail. If a shooter is absent, another shooter will not be permitted to shoot in his place.
6. Allocation of relays and firing points will be done by the Organizing Committee. The particulars of details will be put up on the Notice Board/ website (www.maharifle.org ; www.maharifle.com) **one** day prior to the date of the actual event and all participants should keep themselves informed by referring to the Notice Board/ website/ Telegram Channel (<https://t.me/maharashtrarifleassociation>). **No request regarding specific firing points / relays / dates will be entertained.**
7. Shooters are required to be present at the firing point 15 minutes prior to the commencement of their respective details.
8. Determination of age for sub-youth/ youth/ junior/ Masters/ Senior Masters for the subject competition, shall be the athletes age as on 31.12.2026.
9. An athlete participating in the firearm events, who shoots a score lower than 15% of the of the MQS of the category in which he/she is participating shall be penalized with fine of Rs.2500/-, further if the score achieved is lower than 50% of the MQS of the category in which he/she is participating shall be penalized with fine and Rs.7500/- and appropriate action shall be initiated against such athlete.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at their sole discretion. Any decision given by the Organizing Committee in any matter will be final and binding on all concerned.

The Shooters may contact the Organizing Secretaries for any further information/details that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
