Maharashtra Air and Firearms Competition NR- February/March-2023/1 [MAFC]

[The last date of receipt of online single entries is 17.02.2023]

To,

All Affiliated District Association/Clubs/Unit.

The Maharashtra Rifle Association [MRA] will organize the Maharashtra Air and Firearms Competition February/March -2023/1, [MAFC] NR from 24.02.2023 to 26.02.2023 for Air Gun events at various centers as mentioned hereinbelow and 03.03.2023 – 06.03.2023 for firearm events at the MRA Shooting Ranges, Worli Sea Face North, Mumbai 400030.

The MRA will be organizing MAFC / MAGC (earlier known as MAWC) for the purpose of periodic internal assessment and to enable shooters to qualify for the various State and National Level competitions, as per the rules of the NRAI and the MRA. These competitions are also recognized by MRA for the selection of the various teams that represent Maharashtra State at all the National Level Competitions [only ISSF events]. Please Note: The MAFC / MAGC is an INTERNAL COMPETITION conducted only for the abovementioned purposes and cannot be used for any schemes including but not limited to the 5% quota for jobs and the 25 marks for the SSC and HSC students announced by the Department of Sports – Govt. of Maharashtra. The scores achieved by shooters in the MAFC / MAGC can only be applied for the abovementioned purpose /s and no other purpose whatsoever.

The Open Sight Air Rifle event will be conducted in the format of the MAFC / MAGC only for the students of schools and junior colleges who are below 19 years, for the purpose of qualifying for the National Inter School competition conducted by the NRAI.

The Air Gun Matches will be held at the following Centers.

AMMUNITION:

Imported ammunition and Pellets will be issued to all participants as per the norms approved by the Managing Committee and as per the availability. Details of the norms and issue procedures for imported ammunition/pellets will be put up on the Notice Board at the MRA Shooting Range prior to the commencement of the competition. Participants should keep in touch with the 'Notice Board' / Website for updated information.

COMPETITION RULES:

1. Shooters desiring to participate in the competition should complete the ONLINE (www.maharifle.org) entry form. The last date of receipt of single-entry form / fee is 17.02.2023 till 1700 hrs. Entries may be accepted until 1700 hours on 19.02.2023 with payment of double entry fee.
2. All weapons and ammunition must comply with NRAI / ISSF Rules.
3. All the matches will be conducted as per ISSF rules & NRAI Match Book.
4. Participants will have to bring their own arms/ammunition and other equipment. ONE WEAPON, CAN BE SHARED BY, NOT MORE THAN 2 SHOOTERS.
5. Absentees will not be allowed to take part in a later detail even if a lane is vacant in that detail.
6. If a participant is absent, another participant will not be permitted to shoot in his place.
7. The particulars of details will be put up on the MRA Website (www.maharifle.com) / Facebook Page / Range Notice Board one day prior to the date of the actual event and all participants should keep themselves informed by referring to the same.
8. No request regarding firing points / relays / dates will be entertained, irrespective of the fact whether the entry form is accepted.
9. A participant is required to be present at the firing point 15 minutes prior to the commencement of his detail.
10. No CERTIFICATES will be issued for the MAFC /MAGC.
11. An athlete who does not complete 16/18/21 years of age on 24.02.2023 shall be considered sub-youth/youth/junior respectively and an athlete who shall complete 45/60 on or before 23.02.2023 shall be considered masters/senior-masters respectively.

For the purposes of this competition, those shooters are “**MQS**” shooters who have participated earlier in the NSCC/ G.V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship, West Zone Shooting Championship, Maharashtra State Shooting Championship and Capt. S. J. Ezekiel Memorial Maharashtra State Shooting Championship- Novices (NR Category), but are required to once again achieve the required MQS to participate in the Pre-National Competitions.

IMPORTANT NOTE for the participants of the FIREARM EVENTS:

Competitors desirous of participating in the pistol/peep – firearm events, must have fulfilled the following:

- a. Must have trained for at least 3 sessions/matches with the firearm that s/he would use in the competition, in the presence of an authorized official of the MRA/DRA/Club/registered unit/Renowned shot of that event.
- b. The official must certify that the shooter has achieved the requisite qualifying score [Chart A] in at least one training session.

Prescribed form in which such certificate as enumerated supra is at Appendix ‘A’ to the present circular. A hard copy of such certificate should be produced at the time of start of his/her relay.

ANY FALSE DECLARATION IS LIABLE FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

Shooters desirous of using MRA firearms must inform the MRA, of the date/s on which s/he would like to train and shoot the practice matches in the presence of an authorized official. Shooters requiring coaching for the different matches in the firearm events may inform the MRA and the same would be arranged.

This rule would not apply to those shooters who have achieved the requisite score in previous [recognized] competitions.

The Shooters may contact the Organizing Secretary/ General Secretary for any further information/details that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
