Maharashtra Air Gun Competition- August/September- 2023/2

To,
All Affiliated District Association/Clubs/Unit,

The Maharashtra Rifle Association [MRA] will organize the Maharashtra Air Gun Competition- August/September- 2023/2, [MAGC] on 28.08.2023 and 29.08.2023 at Nashik & Kolhapur and from 01.09.2023 to 03.09.2023 at Mumbai. Particulars of venues is as under:

1. Nashik - X-L Target Shooters Association, Add.- Bhismaraj Bam Memorial Shooting Range, Satpur club house, Satpur MIDC, Trimbak Rd., In front of Indian Valve Company, ESI Ground, Nashik.
2. Kolhapur -Kolhapur District Men & Women Rifle Association, Add.- Dudhali Shooting Range, Dharmveer Sambhaji Nembhaji Prashikshan Kendra, Dudhali Pavilion, Nr. Rankala S.T. Stand, Kolhapur.
3. Mumbai - MRA Shooting Ranges, Worli Seaface North, Sir Pochkhanwala Road, Worli, Mumbai – 400030.

The MRA organizes MAGC for the purpose of periodic internal assessment and to enable shooters to qualify for the various State and National Level competitions, as per the rules of the NRAI and the MRA. These competitions are also recognized by MRA for the selection of the various teams that represent Maharashtra State at all the National Level Competitions. Please Note: The MAGC is an INTERNAL COMPETITION conducted only for the above-mentioned purposes and cannot be used for any schemes like the 5% quota for jobs and the 25 marks for the SSC and HSC students announced by the Department of Sports – Govt. of Maharashtra. The scores achieved by shooters in the MAGC can only be utilized for the above-mentioned purpose and no other purpose whatsoever.

The Open Sight Air Rifle event will be conducted in the format of the MAGC only for the students of schools and junior colleges who are below 19 years, for the purpose of qualifying for the National Inter School competition conducted by the NRAI. There will be only one category Open Sight Air Rifle Event

in the MAGC format and the scores achieved in this competition will enable shooters to qualify to participate in the National Inter School competition.

Shooters desirous of participating in the subject competition should complete the ONLINE entry form on www.maharifle.org. The last date of receipt of single-entry fee is 20.08.2023 until 1700 hrs. Entries may be accepted until 1700 hrs. on 22.08.2023 with a payment of double entry fee.

1. All weapons and ammunition must comply with NRAI / ISSF Rules.
2. All the matches will be conducted as per ISSF rules & NRAI Match Book.
3. Participants will have to bring their own arms/ammunition and other equipment.
4. Absentees will not be allowed to take part in a later detail even if a lane is vacant in that detail.
5. If a participant is absent, another participant will not be permitted to shoot in his place.
6. The particulars of details will be put up on the Notice Board one day prior to the date of the actual event and all participants should keep themselves informed by referring to the Notice Board. The MRA will also put the particulars of all details on its website (www.maharifle.com).
7. No request regarding firing points / relays / dates will be entertained, irrespective of the fact whether the entry form is accepted.
8. A participant is required to be present at the firing point 15 minutes prior to the commencement of his detail.
9. Determination of age for sub-youth/ youth/ junior/ masters/ senior masters for the subject competition, shall be the athletes age as on 31.12.2022.
10. Athletes in the senior masters category are permitted to participate in the masters and senior category and athletes in the Masters category are permitted to participate in the Senior category.

No CERTIFICATES will be issued for the MAGC

MQS shooters are those shooters who were qualified for the event but now need to requalify [as per NRAI Match book they are not be eligible to participate in the forthcoming AIGVMSC]. This could be for various reason – for example - due to having being unable to shoot the required MQS in the previous NSCC or there has been a time lapse since their last competition etc.

Zero shooters are those shooters who have already qualified for participation in the forthcoming AIGVMSC but would like to do a practice match. RENOWNED SHOOTERS OF THAT EVENT ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE AS A ZERO SHOOTER. Renowned

shooters are cautioned against submitting their entries as Zero Shooters. They would be liable for disciplinary action.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time, before or during the competition, at its sole discretion without prior notice. Decision of the Organising Committee/ Working Committee in any matter, will be final and binding, upon all concerned.

The Shooters may contact the Organizing Secretary/ Hon. Gen. Secretary for any further information/details that may be required by them and might have not been covered by the above instructions.
